



Gengenbach

In a TV documentary, Gengenbach with its lovely half-timbered houses, was once called a "pearl among the Black Forest towns", and visitors speak of a romantic gem, of Nice of Baden. Travelers approaching Gengenbach are greeted from afar by the church- and watchtowers that invite them into the historical town center, where narrow alleys lead them to picturesque corners. On the market square, the stone knight on top of the fountain bids us welcome. He is a sign of the pride and the self-confidence of the former free imperial town, just as the over 200-year-old town hall. The impressive building and the uncountable romantic half-timbered houses dominate the image of the town.

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
