The idyllic pilgrimage and holiday town of Lautenbach is located in the middle of the Rench Valley and characterized by a magnificent orchard and vineyard landscape. The 15th century pilgrimage church "Maria Krönung" is almost certainly the most beautiful and meaningful church in the region. It has often been called "a true gem among late Gothic sacred buildings". Lautenbach is also known for its good regional cuisine. The small restaurants in the higher elevations allow hikers to take a rustic and quaint break. Numerous farm shops sell diverse fresh produce, and excellent brandies and liquor. Travelers will enjoy a walk along the Rench River during the lovely spring blossoming or on a warm summer evening.
